

## NAME

getsrc - get latest source code

## SYNOPSIS

getsrc [+v] <file\_name> <pr\_directory> <specific\_make\_name>

## DESCRIPTION

This routine retrieves the latest (most up to date) source code for <file\_name>. This is accomplished by using the <specific\_make> argument to access a special data file containing control information. This special file contains the source pack and update pack names and the order in which they are to be searched.

EXAMPLE: getsrc +v gen\_rng01.c pr-1p135 SC5I6

NOTE: The user must ensure that all valid update and source packs are mounted in order for this routine to run properly.

## OPTION

## EFFECT

+v

The user is informed if <file\_name> exists on any other update pack. The output can be quite verbose.

Entering the command name "getsrc" alone, will result in an printout giving the command format and listing all acceptable make names.
