NAME

tkill – terminate all processes associated with a terminal

SYNOPSIS

tkill ttyname ...

DESCRIPTION

Tkill sends a *kill* signal to each one of the processes associated with each one of the teletype name arguments given with the command. For example,

tkill a b

kills all processes with control channel derived from
"/dev/ttya" and "/dev/ttyb".
